DUGOUTS & EQUIPMENT:

At the end of each game, please make sure that the dugout garbage is picked up, and empty garbage pails into the blue bins. Please clean off your line-up boards for the next game. Bases and equipment can be left out during the day (unless raining), but please put it away at the end of the last game.

CONCESSION TICKETS:

• Each coach will receive an envelope containing Concession Tickets stapled together. There are three different colours: hot dog (red); snack (yellow); and drink (orange) stapled together. Players receive one ticket packet with each colour. Tickets are to be handed out to the players either at the end of your last game during the week prior to Tournament Day, or at the end of your first game if on Tournament Day morning. T-Ball and 3-Pitch coaches, please give the tickets to the player's parents. **Lost tickets will not be replaced.**

• **Coaches, you get 2 hot dog (red) tickets** (which can be exchanged for a hamburger), along with snack (yellow) and drink (orange) ticket. Please don't mix up coach ticket packets with the player ticket packets.

HANDOUT OF TROPHIES/AWARDS:

At the end of your second (or last) game, awards will be handed out to **all** players. Please have your team line up along the 1st and/or 3rd baseline for award presentations. If you do not see an MMAA Representative at your diamond with awards near the end of your game, send someone to the Concession Stand to get an MMAA Representative. If any awards are left over for **absent players**, please return them with absent player names and the MMAA will arrange to distribute them.

PLAYER EVALUATIONS:

For 3-Pitch, Atom, PeeWee and Bantam, we ask that the Coaches take a few minutes to complete a **Player Evaluation Form**. These are important to help us make future teams. Please return the completed form to the labelled **COACH BOX** at the Concession Stand.
