

2025 MMAA SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT / BBQ DAY INFORMATION NOTE

PARENTS & PLAYERS

- Arrive **at least 20 minutes** before game time. Coaches please notify your players of playoff game time.
- Players **MUST** wear appropriate clothing – no shorts, no sandals, no sunglasses, etc.
- Parents ensure your children have sufficient fluids/water and adequate sun protection.
- The Portable Toilets will be very busy, so make sure your kids go before coming to the diamonds.
- Dress for the weather and the possibility of rain (change of clothing, umbrellas, jackets, etc.)
- **LOST & FOUND** will be at the Sea-Can / Concession Stand. Leave no belongings behind.
- Please RECYCLE your **EMPTY** plastic bottles and aluminum cans in the marked recycle bins.
- The parking lot will be congested, so please do not take up excessive parking space and consider carpooling. For emergency and event access, please do not park in front of the vehicle access gate to the diamonds at the south end of the parking lot.
- If you have any spare time, we can always use help at the BBQ or Concession Stand. Several Concession volunteers also have to coach, so **we really need help** between 11:00 am and 2:30 pm – even for an hour. We also need help at the end of Tournament Day for clean-up and take-down.

FOOD & DRINK CONCESSION STAND:

- Food & refreshments will be available at the Concession Stand while quantities last. BBQ food will be ready around 11:15 am. Coffee will be available earlier in the morning.
- Bring **CASH** money to purchase food and refreshments at the Concession Stand.
- **Prices:** Hot Dog \$1.00 / Juicy Jumbo Hot Dog \$1.50 / Hamburger \$2.50 / Chips \$1.00 / Candy-Freezie \$1.50 / Coffee \$0.50 / Pop-Juice-Water \$1.00 / Gatorade \$1.50.
- There will be free Concession Tickets for Players & Coaches, which will be handed out to players either at the end of their last regular game prior to Tournament Day, or at the end of the first game Tournament Day morning. T-Ball and 3-Pitch Coaches, please give the tickets to the players' parents. Be sure you bring them with you as player tickets will not be replaced.
- **Players** receive **3** concession tickets: a pink ticket for a hot dog (T-Ball, 3-Pitch, Atom); a red ticket for a Juicy Jumbo hot dog (PeeWee & Bantam); a yellow ticket for a bag of chips; a blue ticket for a pop, juice, or water.
- **Coaches** receive **4** concession tickets: 2 red tickets for 2 Juicy Jumbo hot dogs OR 1 hamburger; a yellow ticket for a bag of chips; and a blue ticket for a soft drink, juice, or water. Coaches make sure you keep your sets of 4 tickets.

UMPIRES

Umpires may be needed throughout the day. Umpires, if you are not playing, come check the schedule at the Sea-Can to sign up for a game when you're not playing. Find Karen at the Concession Stand for your umpire pay when you are heading home for the day.

COACHES

DUGOUTS & EQUIPMENT: At the end of each game, please make sure that the dugout garbage is picked up, and empty garbage pails. Clean off your white board. Bases and equipment can be left out during the day (unless raining), but please put gear away at the end of the last game.

TROPHIES / AWARDS: At the end of your last game, awards will be handed out to your team. Please have your team line up along the 1st and/or 3rd baseline for award presentations. If you do not see an MMAA Representative at your diamond with awards near the end of your game, send someone to the Concession Stand to notify an MMAA Representative. For any absent players, Coaches please keep their award and make arrangements with them directly to collect it from you.

PLAYER EVALUATIONS: Coaches please take a few minutes to complete a **Player Evaluation Form**. These are important in helping us make teams next season. Please return the completed form to the labelled **COACH BOX** at the Concession Stand.
